## TASTING NOTES



Southern France has a history of 2000 years as one of the most significant grape growing areas in the world. In the past 20 years in particular, the region has been sparked by wines of extraordinary quality due to a renewed respect for what the fruit is capable of, coupled with cutting edge viticulture and winemaking that the grapes deserve. The warmer climates coupled with the maritime location produces wines that are more full bodied and rich in flavours and textures. Consistency and value for money is another hallmark of this region.

### GRAPES

100% Chardonnay

### ORIGIN OF GRAPES

IGP Pays d'Oc - South of France. This region benefits from the Mediterranean climate. With its coastline bordering the region in the South, it provides hot and dry summers for a perfect maturity. On the other side, the Black Mountain brings enough humidity and cool temperatures for the vineyards to produce grapes packed with fruity aromas. The terroir effect is very noticeable in this region due to the great variety of winegrowing areas that create an expression of the grape varieties that is unique.

### WINEMAKING

We crafted this wine from grapes selected in distinct vineyards from our best Chardonnay vines. After a short maceration, the crop is gently pressed. Both the vinification and maturing process are carried out under the influence of differently toasted French oak, revealing extraordinary flavours. After the fermentation, the fine yeast is stirred up periodically giving the wine its velvety mouthfeel.

### COLOUR

Golden yellow.

### NOSE

Intense aromas of ripe apple, elegant bourbon vanilla and some toffee notes.

### TASTE

Dense on the palate, wonderfully smooth and velvety, subtle spicy notes on the long finish.
