SPY VALLEY SINGLE ESTATE GEWÜRZTRAMINER 2017

Region	Marlborough, New Zealand.
Vineyard	Johnson Vineyard, Waihopai Valley - alluvial stony silt loam, very well drained. Clones GM12, 14, 457, 1106, 1148.
Viticulture	Viticulturist - Adam McCone. Vertical shoot positioning, shoot and bunch thinning to restrict yield. Open canopies with high bunch exposure to sunlight.
Winemaking	Winemakers - Paul Bourgeois, Richelle Collier. Early morning picking of four separate parcels, three with overnight skin contact. Fermented mainly in old oak ovals over several months then blended together before bottling.
Aroma	Mango, ginger, nutmeg and rose petal.
Palate	Powerful fruit flavours support a smooth flowing structure that lingers in the mouth.
Technical	Pick dates 28 March - 10 April 2017 Brix 22.4- 24.1 °Brix Alcohol 13.5% Acid T.A 4.1 g/L Residual sugar 11 g/L
Cellaring	Although deliciously fruity when young, there is structure to give the option of cellaring for several years. The optimum suggested drinking window would be from 1-5 years after harvest.
