Viticulture	Awatere Valley - loess over deep free draining gravel.

Winemaking	Clones: MS. Vertical shoot positioning, shoot and bunch thinning to restrict yield.

Technical	Harvested predominantly in the cool of early morning, gentle juice extraction, and pressing under inert gas. Cool settled and mainly fermented in stainless steel tanks.
