Selectively hand-picked in the cool of the morning, and immediately pressed direct to an old oak vessel for natural fermentation. Left to mature on lees

for 6 months and bottled December 2015.

Aroma Peach and blueberry fruits with jasmine florals and notes of lime, tarragon and cardamom.

Palate Although the alcohol is light, the palate is defined by firm structure and acidity. With balancing residual sugar, the overall impression is approachability with a drying finish.
